# WHAT IS A LEARNING COMMUNITY?

At Meadowlark School, Learning Communities (LCs) are innovative, student-centered spaces designed to promote collaboration, creativity, and personalized learning.



Instead of traditional classrooms, LCs create flexible environments where students and teachers work together in shared spaces. This approach fosters a sense of belonging and encourages peer interaction across diverse age groups or abilities, enhancing both academic and social development.

### WHAT IS PROJECT BASED LEARNING?

Project-Based Learning (PBL) at Meadowlark School is a hands-on, student-centered approach where students solve real-world problems through collaborative projects. It integrates multiple subjects, encouraging inquiry, critical thinking, and creativity.

Students work in teams, guided by teachers, to explore topics deeply, research solutions, and present their findings through exhibitions or



portfolios. For example, a sustainable garden project might blend science, math, and writing.

This method helps students connect learning to real life while building skills like problem-solving and teamwork, preparing them for future success.
